

EAGLE FEATHER: NOVA SCOTIA TO EDINBURGH

"For as the Lightning cometh out of the east and shineth even unto the west, so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be. For wheresoever that which is fallen is, there will the eagles be gathered together." (Matthew 24:27-31)

West-to-East (Major Human vectors, to US East Coast):

1. 1978. The LONGEST WALK; Native Nations (tribes) walked from California to Washington DC. Hawaii represented, Hierarchical project, Templar related.
2. 2008, concurrent with Atlantic Conf. 2nd LONGEST WALK; Hawaii linked at Crestone, Native ritual on Solstice.
